1. Aim

The AEL Course aims to nurture internationally-minded educational professionals who address educational challenges in contemporary Asia. Specifically, it nurtures (1) Educational researchers capable of undertaking comparative analysis of educational issues in Asia; (2) Educational practitioners capable of engaging with researchers, policymakers and other stakeholders; and (3) Educational administrators with the knowledge and skills required to collaborate with partners across the region.

2. Partner institutes

The AEL Course has been established by consensus among seven partner institutes of six universities in Asia which in turn host the summer and winter courses. The seven partner institutes are as follows.

- Graduate School of Education, Tohoku University (TU), Sendai
- College of Education, National Chengchi University (NCCU), Taipei
- School of Education Science, Nanjing Normal University (NNU), Nanjing
- School of Psychology, Nanjing Normal University (NNU), Nanjing
- Department of Education, Korea University (KU), Seoul
- College of Education, National Taiwan Normal University (NTNU), Taipei
- Faculty of Education, Chulalongkorn University (CU), Bangkok

3. Curriculum and schedule 2026-2027

The AEL Course is held every summer and winter break for about 10 days. Three subjects are offered, one for each strand of the KAS-P (knowledge, attitude, skills and practice) curriculum. Please refer to AEL Course Brochure 2026-2027 for curriculum details.

5. Enrolment capacity and qualification for application

The host university offers a student quota of TEN (maximum) to each partner university (twenty in total for Nanjing Normal University). Applications will be screened by individual universities. **Only those recommended by AELC member universities can apply.**

Applicants should:

- (1) Be regularly enrolled graduate or undergraduates students of the partner universities and
- (2) Be capable of participating in classes conducted in English (TOEFL/PBT score of 500 or above, CET score of 425 or above, or equivalent).

- 1) Receive approval from an AELC professor or administrator at your school.

8. Registration for AEL Course

New students enrolled in the 2026 Summer Course will be registered as AEL Course students.

9. Credit requirements for AEL Course Joint Certificate of Completion

Upon successful application, a Joint Certificate of Completion will be issued to students who have earned at least 12 AEL credits, of which (1) six credits are not from the home university and (2) at least two credits each are from the K-P, A-P and S-P subjects respectively.

Registration and tuition fees are exempted.
