2 Eligibility

International students enrolled at Tohoku University as of April 2023 are eligible (undergraduate students, graduate students, research students, non-degree students, special auditing students, special research students).

(1) Current students (including students who once lived in a university dorm) can apply for dormitory rooms. However, new students will be given priority in the selection process.

And if they violated the dorm rules or disturbed other residents during their previous residence, they will not be permitted to live in a dorm again.

- (2) Students planning to enter Tohoku University from this April must apply to the dorm rooms now.
- (3) Please confirm the following before applying for dormitories.
 - ① UH Aobayama residents have to pay ¥5,600 every month (for mandatory services for all residents -bedding and housewares rental etc.) besides rent. Please note that <u>residents</u> <u>cannot refuse any of the services</u> even if they do not need them.
 - ② Smoking is prohibited everywhere on all Tohoku University campuses. Because university dormitories are part of the campus; residents cannot smoke in the dorms or on the premises. If you wish to smoke, please apply for a private apartment. <u>Especially, because University Houses are shared-type dormitories, smokers cannot apply.</u>
 - ③ International House Sanjo 1 and Higashi-Sendai are old dormitories and their room conditions are not good. There may be mold and damage to the walls, furniture, etc. Please be aware of this when applying for them.
- 3 Duration of Stay

In general, one of the periods below. You can apply for UH Aobayama for 2 years or shorter, or other dorms for 1 year or shorter. <u>Residents cannot stay in dorms for longer than</u> these designated residence periods (excluding UH Nagamachi, IH Higashi-Sendai and Couple's room residents).

IH Higashi Sendai and UH Nagamachi residents are allowed to stay until the end of their enrollment period, but they need to apply for an extension of stay every year. If you choose IH Higashi Sendai or UH Nagamachi as your first choice, please enter a residence period of less than 1 year.

Please refer to "7 Move-in date " for the move-in start date.

*1 The end of the period of stay is March 15 or September 15 in all student dormitories, except for exchange students who are accepted for a fixed period of time.

(If March 15 or September 15 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the end of the period of stay will be the weekday immediately preceding that date.)

Due to room cleaning, students cannot stay in the dorms until September 30 (or March 31). I.e., you will not be able to stay in your room until the day of the graduation ceremony.

2 Rent for final month of residence

If students leave the dorm by the 15th day of the final month of the approved period of stay, rent and management charges for the relevant month will be half of the regular fee. <u>However, students whose duration of stay is scheduled to end on September 15</u> <u>are not eligible to receive this discount for August even if they leave before August 15.</u> <u>This discount applies only to the final month written on the resident's permit.</u> Please take note of this when entering your residence period if you are short-term student.

5 How to apply

Please enter your information on the 'Application for Tohoku University's University House and International House ' (Form 1-1, 1-2) and submit it to the section in charge of international students in your department.

Students can ask their academic advisor at Tohoku University to apply for them.

6 Announcement of Selection Outcome

Students will be contacted by mid-February via the heads of their departments.

7 Move-in Date

Please attend the registration meeting at your dorm on the day you arrive. After the meeting, you will receive your room key. Students can start moving into their dorms on the date below.

March 27, 2023 (Mon.)

- *1 Please enter April 1 for your move-in date on your application.
 We will issue a residence permit based on your move-in date when we are informed your arrival date.
- ※2 Students cannot move in on Saturdays and Sundays. If you wish to move into your

dormitory on weekends, someone in your lab needs to receive your room key in advance.

8 Residence Permit Cancellation & Eviction

Those who fail to move in within seven days of the start of the move-in period without providing a reason, allow unauthorized persons to stay overnight in their rooms, violate University House Management Regulations or International House Regulations, or disobey instructions issued by the university or the dormitory office, may lose their Residence Permit or be evicted.

- (1) Please be sure to confirm that every form is filled out. If any forms are incomplete, it may be considered during selection. If your student ID number or your academic advisor has not been determined, please enter 'undecided'. If you cannot input katakana, please leave the relevant boxes blank.
- (2) For research students who plan to enter graduate school, if your current planned period of enrollment is 6 months, please apply for that period. Please apply for an extension at the time of entering the graduate school.

The residence period of UH Aobayama is different from that of the other dorms. Please enter the residence period for your first choice on your application.

(3) Students who wish to apply for a couple's or family room must attach the documents listed below.

If family members are in Japan:

• Copy of documents proving relationship with applicant (National Health Insurance card etc.)

If family members will come to Japan later:

- · Copy of documents proving relationship with applicant (marriage license etc.)
- Copy of Certificate of Eligibility for family members coming to Japan or application receipt issued by Immigration Bureau of Japan proving that they have applied for a Certificate of Eligibility.

If coming to Japan together with family members:

• Copy of documents proving relationship with applicant (marriage license etc.), passports of accompanying family members

• As a condition of applying, if the applicant is engaged, but not yet married, to the accompanying person, s/he must be able to submit the above documents by the date on which they will move in.

• Applicants who cannot provide the above documents when applying should attach a written explanation to their application, then submit the documents later.

(B) Application for Extension of Residence Period

1 Eligibility

[UH Sanjo, Sanjo II, III, UH Katahira , IH Sanjo1,2 ····Single room or Family room]

Students who moved into a dorm on and after October 1, 2022 and given permission to live there until March 15, 2023.

*Students can apply to extend this by six months (until September 15, 2023).

【UH Aobayama】

- X1 Students who moved into a dorm on and after October 1,2021 and given permission to live there until March 15, 2023.
 - *Students can apply to extend this by six month (until September 15, 2023)
- X2 Students who moved into a dorm on and after April 1, 2022 and given permission to live there until March 15,2023.

*Students can apply to extend this by one year (until March 15, 2024)

- Students who moved into a dorm on and after October 1, 2022 and given permission to live there until March 15, 2023.
 *Students can apply to extend this <u>by 1 and a half years (until September 13, 2024)</u>.
- If you are a research student who will enter a graduate school from April 2023, <u>please</u> <u>be aware that you will need to stay in an apartment for your final half year</u> because students can live in UH Aobayama for two years maximum, even if their enrollment period is two and a half years.

[UH Nagamachi, IH Higashi-Sendai and IH Sanjo 1,2 Couple's room,]

Students who given permission to live in a dorm until March 15, 2023. * Students can apply to extend this <u>by one year (until March 15, 2024)</u>.

- ※1 Please be aware that you can't apply for extension of your stay until the end of September or March. If you wish to stay in Sendai until the end of March or September, you need to find somewhere to stay outside the campus.
- 2 Due to space limitations, family room residents cannot extend their stay (excluding students given permission to live in a dorm from on and after October 1. 2022 to March 15, 2023).
